

#### **FROM THE QUILTING ANSWER BOOK:**

**Q - How do I keep my binding from getting tangled and twisted while I sew it to the Quilt?**

**A - Here is an easy way to corral your binding. Wrap the binding around your fingers into a loose coil or into a ball and tuck it into a gallon size ziploc bag. When you are ready to apply it, partially open the bag and pull out the pressed end. Drop the bag on the floor by your feet or tape it to the edge of the sewing-machine table. The binding will feed from the bag as you sew.**

**Another idea:** Cut a slit in the top of a clean, discarded butter tub or other inexpensive plastic storage container. Place the rolled binding inside, and feed the beginning end of the binding through the slit. Hold the tub in your lap or put it on the floor close to your feet. No more tangles, just even feeding!
