

A Tip From Kathy Bennett:

Neatly fold large fabric pieces. "I use an 8" x 24" ruler to wrap the fabric around, just like a bolt. Then slide it off halfway and fold. The folded edge becomes a clean front edge when stacked on the shelf. Just as with library books on a shelf, I line up all the front edges of the folded fabrics, leaving any mismatches at the back." *Lois L. Hallock (clearview-designs.com)*
