Well Ladies, we are into March and hopefully some SPRING-like weather. This month's program will focus on placemats and runners with our own Shirley Dunphy presenting a short trunk show

of many of the these items she has made over the years. I for one am really looking forward to this display and hearing the stories behind each of the pieces Shirley will be showing us.

Patterns ordered at last month for the pillows that Sandra and Trisha presented to the group will be available for pick-up during this meeting.

I am closing with the tips/hints that Sandra spoke to all of you about making successful pillows:

- Use a pillow form ½" – 1" larger than the pillow cover for a good fit.
- Back your completed pillow top with muslin or iron-on pella to give added stability.
- Ruffle should be 2 ½ times the perimeter of the pillow. Gather by stitching with long stitches and pulling thread (or hand gathering).
- Easy pleating using long darning needle. Allow extra fullness around the corners.
- Closing the pillow – slip stitching the fourth side – button back or Velcro – tie back.
- Can't make a "whole quilt???" ..... Make a pillow!
- If you have to make your own pillow form, use small pieced of stuffing and keep smoothing the outside so you don't have lumps.

### MINUTES OF FEBRUARY MEETING

The February meeting of the WQG was held Monday, February 7th at St Gertrude's Church Hall. The meeting was called to order at 7 pm by vice-president, Cathy Crowley. A welcome was extended to our newest member, Andrea Rennick.

The minutes of the January meeting were approved as written in the newsletter. The treasurer's report was approved as written. A question arose re the cashing in of the Guild's GIC- the full amount of that cheque was given to the planning group for the Quilt Show and will be spent on additional quilt racks. If there are any unused funds, they will be returned to the WQG account.

Correspondence included a thank-you note from Florence Sproul for the quilt given her while she was in chemotherapy. A note was also received from the Marco Polo Quilt Guild seeking quilt entries to be considered for the Marco Polo Quilt Guild N.B. Contemporary Quilt Award. More information re this award is available from Cathy Crowley if anyone is interested.

The Quilt Show is coming up May 6-7, 2011. Linda MacAffee reported that next month a list will be circulated to the members so they can identify items they will have for sale in the "Market" section of the show. Toni O'Brien reviewed the protocol regarding quilt items which are to be in the "Display" section of the show. The registration of those items is essential and can be done by e-mail or in writing. Registration deadline is April 4th. The protocol and registration forms are on the WQG website and paper copies will be available at our next meeting as well.

Materials to make Fabric Bowls for the CQA project are available and anyone making those bowls should have them completed and back by our March meeting.

A sign-up sheet is available for the dyeing class which will be held on the SS in April.

Twenty people are needed for this class (15 are presently on the list).

On SS-Feb.19th, the group will be working on comfort quilts. Bring any scraps that might be appropriate for that day and bring a brown bag lunch. Linda M. has a pattern for a 6 hr. quilt which she will share that day.

The group was made aware that Maxine O'Donnell, a former quilter member was burned out recently. A list will be circulated for donations of quilt-related items to give to her.

Members are needed to help sell tickets on the raffle quilt at Sobey's on April 15th. A sign-up list is available if you can help.

The business meeting ended at 7:45 and was followed by program, coffee, and show and tell.

### SCALLOPED POTATOES

The request for this recipe came at one of our SUPER SATURDAYS. I used to make Potato Scallop the old way (without a recipe) but this one is SO much better!

Cook in a double boiler:

- 4 tablespoons butter
- 4 tablespoons flour
- 1 ½ teaspoons salt (or less if you like)
- 1/8 teaspoon pepper
- 2 cups milk

Stir constantly until sauce is thickened.

- Peel 6-8 medium sized potatoes
- 1 large onion

Slice thinly. Layer half of the potatoes and onions in a 2 Qt. Casserole. Pour half the sauce over. Layer rest of the potatoes and onions on top. Cover with rest of sauce. Bake covered in a 350 degree oven for 50 minutes. Uncover and bake an additional 10-15 minutes to brown the scalloped potatoes. Serves 6.
