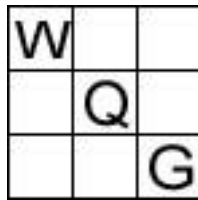

4. Can drop off entry or email.
5. If not at April meeting, last call for them is April 26.
6. 5 large quilts will hang as space allows.
7. Small quilts may be displayed on small quilt racks or double on regular display racks
8. New category – Groups of friends.
9. 5 large quilts no matter what category.
10. 105” quilts may be on racks or hung from balcony. May need to be turned up on bottom. Will get back to us regarding this.
11. Pick up between 5-6 pm on Saturday May 4.
12. Please have measurements for large quilts.
13. Sleeves 6”.
14. Back of sleeve please have name and dimensions
15. Bring them in a clear bag. DO NOT USE black garbage bags.

## **Beginner Free Motion Quilting Workshop**

Super Saturday

**April 27th, 2019**

Supplies List:

1. Several sheets of paper and a pencil/pen.
2. Sewing machine with free motion or darning foot and any other free motion aids like gloves, supreme slider, etc.

3. Please bring 9 prepared quilt sandwiches all the same size – 10 inches squares would be a good size.

(Use batting of your own choice. We will be discussing batting in the workshop, but you can use whatever you would like. For less puff, choose cotton, for more puff use wool, polyester, or a combination of these)

Use either sold fabric, or fabric with very little pattern. (white on white is also a good choice.) Use the same or similar fabric for both sides of the sandwich so thread color can be the same for bobbin and top thread.

4. Thread to match your fabric.

5. Ruler at least #10 inches

6. A blue “water soluble” pen, if you have one.

7. A scrap sandwich- any size, any fabric - to test tension.

### **May Super Sat is May 11th.**

Here is the supply list that you can get ready early .

For the Star Quilt you will need 75, 5 inch squares or 2 charm packs.

**Star Fabric** 1/2 yard - cut into five - 5 inch squares and forty -3 inch squares

**Border Fabric** 1 1/4 yards if you do not want to piece it, or 2/3 yards

**Optional 2nd Border** 1 1/2 or 2 yards

**binding** 1/2 yard. Size is 41 x 50 or bigger with 2nd Border

### 5" charm swap

1. Choose a good quality fabric that is in the guidelines, preferably pre washed. Square up. Cut one 5" strip from the width of fabric. Cut off all salvages. Sub cut into eight 5" squares. Set one aside for yourself. Place 7 charms into a ziplock bag and place your name and the name of the swap in or on the bag. ie Janet W blue

You may do multiple sets within each section. Only good quality fabric cut accurately.

April - white/beige - all colors is to be white or beige (no other colors in the charm) no muslin but tone on tone is allowed

May - black - all over color is black, prints allowed, lights to darks

June - blue - all over color is blue, prints allowed, lights to darks  
Sept - pink - all over color is pink, prints allowed, lights to darks  
Oct - pastel - all over color is pastel, prints allowed, lights only  
Nov - green - all over color is green, prints allowed, lights to darks  
Dec - red - all over color is red, prints allowed, lights to darks  
Jan - gray - all over color is gray, prints allowed, lights to darks
