Cutting Instructions


Fabric A	Fabric B
4 – 3 ½" x 2"	36 – 3 ½" x 12 ½"
4 – 2" x 11"	20 – 3 ½" x 2"
4 – 2" x 12 ½"	16 – 2" x 12 ½"
8 – 2" strips width of fabric	4 – 2" x 2"
9 – 4 ½" strips width of fabric	9 – 2" strips width of fabric
Fabric D	Fabric E
24 – 3 ½" x 3 ½"	192 – 2" x 2"



- 1. Using Fabric A 3 ½" x 2" and Fabric E 2", make 4 flying geese.
- 2. Using Fabric A 2" x 11", sew one on each side of flying goose. Make 2



3. Sew to opposite sides of medallion (made earlier). NOTE placement of points



- 4. Using Fabric A 2" x 12 ½", sew one on each side of flying goose. Like step 2 (see diagram). Make 2.
- 5. Sew to other 2 sides of medallion. Should measure 27 % x 27 % "



Sashing

6. Using Fabric B 3 ½" x 12 ½", sew a Fabric E 2" x 2" on opposite corners (sew corner to corner). Trim and press.



Make 36.

7. Using Fabric E 2" x 2", do the same on the opposite corners. Trim and press. Make 36. This unit is now referred to as your sashing unit.



8. Using 5 Fabric D 3 ½" x 3 ½" and 4 sashing units, make this. Make 4




9. Using 2 Fabric D 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " and one sashing unit, make this. Make 2.



Row construction

10. Feel free to change the blocks to suit yourself. Row 1 – Use 5 sashing units and 4 blocks. Make 2 (top and bottom row)



11. Construct center row. Sew a sashing unit to each side of block. Then use unit from #9 to construct. Do twice. Make 2 center rows.




12. Sew the medallion in between the 2 center rows.



13. Sew a unit made in Step 8 to the TOP and BOTTOM of the block unit made in Step 10. Do for both rows.



14. Sew center section to the top and bottom.









16. Using five of the geese and four of the Fabric B 2" x 12 ½", make this. Make 4


- 17. Sew one unit to the side of your quilt body. Match your star points. Sew one on the opposite side.
- 18. Take the last two units you just made. Sew a Fabric B 2" x 2" on both ends. Do this twice.





Borders

- 20. Sew your Fabric A 2" strips together end to end. Using your favorite method, sew on the first border.
- 21. Sew your Fabric B 2" strips together end to end. Using your favorite method, sew on the second border.
- 22. Sew your Fabric A 4 ½" strips together end to end. Using your favorite method, sew on the last border. Sandwich and quilt.
