

Welcome to the New Year. Hope you had a wonderful holiday and are getting back to sewing.

Tip of the month: Never get discouraged when trying a new pattern or learning a new technique. The more you practice, the better you get.

Press the wrong side of the block or the quilt first to get your seams going in the right direction. Then press the right side.

Most quilters are finishing up projects for Christmas at the last minute. I am presenting a Christmas quilt. A row by Row starting next month. You will be finished in 5 months, so a gift will be done early. The size is 58×70 inches.

Materials needed are:

- 2 7/8 yards background
- 1 1/2 yards assorted greens
- 1 yard different reds
- 1 -2 yards assorted Yellows, Blues or scraps of Christmas fabric left over from other projects.

I am using scraps. I will show the first row but give the direction next month when you have your fabric. Hope you enjoy this quilt.
