SUPER SATURDAY

Super Saturday for April 13th

This pattern is being taught by me, Doreen

This block will do up fast and before you know it you'll have a quilt top.

Fabric needed as follows:

This pattern uses layer cakes 10"squares so if you want to use your stash cut your blocks 10"square.

Throw size 48"x 67" one layer cake or 30 squares 8 lt, 8 med, 8dark, 6 very dk

Double Size 67" x 86" 2 layer cakes

King Size 113" x113" 4 layer cakes

If you want to do a small one or baby one use a charm pks.

Super Saturday for May:

Susan Hayden will teach the Chenille Runner. Here are the materials needed.

3 pieces of print fabric - repeats approx 24" x width of fabric (large print works best)

1 piece of backing 26" X WOF (a solid that coordinates with the print)

1 piece of backing 28" x WOF (this can be the print fabric or the solid)

Other supplies:

1 piece of batting 28" x 44"

thread to coordinate with your print and backing

chenille cutter if you have one - I have one and so do a few other people and we can share them on Super Saturday.

PROGRAM FOR APRIL 2013

Jelly Roll Lotto: The color for this month's Jelly Roll strip is Black Prints. Remember, NOT Black and white or black and beige...the black must have a color print in it. Black adds such a spark of interest to a quilt and it doesn't get used nearly often enough. Shelley will be accepting your strips this month. Next month, bring 2 ½" x WOF strips in 1930's reproduction prints. This will be a fun one! We are always excited to see what interesting fabrics bring for the Jelly Roll Lotto.

Fabric Challenge

Are you up for a challenge???? Well, last month we had 25 guild members commit to say "YES!!!!!!!" At tonight's meeting, those people who signed up need to go see Janet Wright. She will give you a small brown paper bag. In said bag, there is a piece of fabric and a short overview of the rules. **DO NOT OPEN THE BAG AT THE MEETING!!!** You have until the JUNE meeting to return your challenge. First prize is that beautiful quilt rack that Shelley emailed the picture of. Second and third prize will be announced.

To qualify AND have your project submitted/accepted for judging, you have to:

1. Make something, anything, but no larger than 24" x 24"
2. **Completely** finish that item. Uncompleted projects will not be accepted.
3. Use challenge fabric in the top or front of your project (not as backing).

The judges will be using this as criteria for winning:

1. How well the fabric was used in your project
2. Creativity

So, leave the fabric in the bag at the meeting. Take it home and use the fabric to make something creative!!!! We can't wait to see what happens!!

This month, Shelley will be showing you a "BIG BLOCK" pattern for using more stash! Has anyone figured out what program is encouraging you to do this year.

Did you Know??? The Woodstock Quilt Guild now has its own Facebook Group. This is a closed group for members only of the Woodstock Quilt guild and a few of our "Friends" from other local guilds. Janet Wright has to approve membership, so be assured that every Tom, Dick and Harry will not be hanging out there lol! It's a group for sharing and keeping members connected during the month.
