

## Fons and Porter's Quilt Tips:

- the plastic tray inserts from cookie packages make excellent spool caddies and keep threads from rolling around in your drawers as well.

- When making a child's quilt, make an extra block or two to applique onto pillowcases to match the quilt.

- Avoid using Fabric Softener in the washer or dryer when you pre-wash fabrics that you later intend to fuse. Fusible web will not adhere properly to fabrics treated with fabric softener.
